Ideas for enablers of change

- Pinpoint obstacles in organisations/educating
- Language used and jargon improve messaging and focus of the concerns/lack of humancentric parratives
- See more diverse symbols not typical/narrowing of icons

• Divide between those who are raising issues and those who are tangibly affected by the effects of climate emergency – eco-anxiety varies and takes different forms
